IN RE: ADMINISTRATION OF GUARDIANSHIPS IN THE
COURT OF CHANCERY

WHEREAS, the following is a change in procedure in the administration of guardianships established by this Court,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED this 3rd day of March, 2010, the following procedure shall apply in all guardianship cases effective immediately:

1) All petitions for guardianship for disabled persons or minor children shall be accompanied by an Affidavit of Petitioner's History in the form attached to this Standing Order and available on the Court of Chancery website. Additionally, the Affidavit of Petitioner's History form must also accompany each petition for appointment of guardian and tort settlement for minor child.
