## COURT OF COMMON PLEAS FOR THE STATE OF DELAWARE SITS IN SPECIAL SESSION FOR THE INVESTITURE OF THE HONORABLE ROBERT H. SURLES

The Court of Common Pleas for the State of Delaware will sit in special session on Friday, February 8, 2013 at 2 p.m. in the New Castle County Courthouse's Courtroom 8B for the investiture of the Honorable Robert H. Judge Surles will preside over cases in New Castle County.
