## ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE OF THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE NO. 2017-2 INTERIM EFILING PROCEDURES

This 284 day of March 2017,

IT APPEARING that the existing eFlex, eFile system will be disabled on March 28, 2017 at midnight, and there will be a period when e-filing will not be available in the Court of Common Pleas.

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the Court will implement a new Civil eFiling system, File and Serve Delaware, effective April 2, 2017 at 8:00 p.m.

IT IS THEREFORE DIRECTED THAT:

- A) All civil proceedings that are required to be eFiled in accordance with *Civil Rule* 79, under Administrative Directive 2017-1 are exempt for the period March 29, 2017, 12:01 a.m. to April 2, 2017, 7:59 p.m. in the following circumstances:
  - (1) In those proceedings where the statute of limitations may run, the party may file the initial Complaint and Answer directly with the Clerk's Office.
- B) Where such filings occur, the following procedures shall apply:
  - (1) The filer shall file in the Clerk's Office by having the pleading date stamped, but should retain the pleadings;

- (2) All such pleadings date stamped hereunder shall subsequently be e-filed in the Delaware File and Serve system within five (5) days of April 2, 2017; and
- (3) The pleading shall be deemed filed on the date which is stamped on the pleading.

This Directive is effective Much 28, 2017.
