Note: The April 2nd, 2017 implementation only affects filers to the Court of Common Pleas. All Justice of the Peace Court filings through the eFlex system will continue to be handled in eFlex. Current eFlex accounts will not be deactivated, but the functionality to allow filing to the Court of Common Pleas will be disabled. A date for the Justice of the Peace Court's transition to File and Serve Delaware will be communicated in the future.
