

Matter of Thomas Alexander, Jr.,
Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law,
No. UPL-2, 1992 (1993)

Nature of Case:

After investigation by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, a petition was filed with the Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law alleging that Alexander had been engaged in the practice of giving legal advice and drafting legal documents in the State of Delaware for a fee, without proper authorization. After several extensions were granted to Alexander to answer the charges, and after such extensions had expired, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel moved to have all of the allegations of the petition deemed admitted. The Board conducted a hearing at which Alexander submitted an answer challenging the Board's jurisdiction over him.

Action Taken by the Court:

After briefing by the parties, the Board issued an Opinion and Order on July 8, 1993 declaring the legal practice activities of Alexander to constitute the unauthorized practice of law in Delaware, and ordering him, as well as all persons working in concert with him, to immediately cease and desist all such legal practice activity in the State of Delaware.
