INDEFINITE SUSPENSION– Rafael D. Acosta, Esquire

By Order of the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware dated May 2, 2012, the Court indefinitely suspended Rafael D. Acosta, Esquire from the practice of law in the State of Delaware. Mr. Acosta failed to appear before the Court as directed and show cause why he should not be suspended as a member of the Delaware Bar for failing to timely file his 2012 annual registration statement with the Court and pay assessment and associated late fees. Mr. Acosta is prohibited from practicing law in this State indefinitely until such time as he petitions the Court for reinstatement and demonstrates, by clear and convincing evidence, his fitness to practice law in the State of Delaware.
