Delaware Supreme Court to Hold Public Hearings  
On Proposed Administrative Directive and  
Proposed Rule Concerning Delaware Court Reporter Certification

The Delaware Supreme Court will hold public hearings on a proposed administrative directive and proposed rule concerning Delaware Court Reporter Certification. The [proposed administrative directive and proposed rule](#) are the result of the work of a task force that was formed at the request of concerned court reporters and the Delaware Trial Lawyers Association. The Delaware Supreme Court neither appointed nor authorized a task force. The President of the Delaware Trial Lawyers Association provided the task force's proposals to the Court. The Court is seeking comments on the task force's proposals.

The proposed administrative directive and proposed rule are attached for your review. Written comments may be submitted to Stephen D. Public hearings on the proposed administrative directive and proposed rule will be held on: (1) Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in the Court of Chancery Courtroom in the Court of Chancery Building, 34 The Circle, Georgetown, DE, (2) Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in the Supreme Court Courtroom in the Delaware Supreme Court Chambers on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor of the Carvel State Office Building, 820 N. French Street, Wilmington, DE and (3) Monday, June 7, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in the Supreme Court Courtroom in the Supreme Court Building, 55 The Green, Dover, DE.

All speakers must register with Stephen D. Taylor, Court Administrator, Delaware Supreme Court, Carvel State Office Building, 820 N. French Street, Wilmington, DE 19801 and indicate which public hearing that they are going to attend. This registration must be completed 3 days prior to the date of the public hearing that a speaker wishes to attend. All speakers are limited to a ten-minute presentation and may submit their written comments to Mr. Taylor at the time of their appearance at one of the public hearings. Individual speakers are limited to one appearance at one of the public hearing locations.
