AMENDED STANDING ORDER

In all cases in which the Court has appointed an attorney ad litem to represent an allegedly disabled person, the attorney shall file a report and recommendation on the petition for guardianship with the Court as directed in the Order of the Court. The attorney shall also file an affidavit of time expended on the matter and a request for a fee and costs. The fee and costs shall not exceed \$750 unless the attorney requests and supports an excess fee and the Court finds that payment of a fee in excess of \$750 is in the best interest of the allegedly disabled person.
