The Honorable Jeffrey J Clark Takes the Oath of Office for
Judge of the Superior Court of Delaware.

The Honorable Jeffrey J. Clark was sworn in for his first term as Judge of the Superior Court of Delaware on Friday, April 10, 2015 at 1 p.m. in Courtroom 1 of the Kent County Courthouse. President Judge Jan R. Jurden presided over the special session along with Kent County Resident Judge William L. Witham Jr., and Judge Robert B. Young. Randy J. Holland, Supreme Court Justice administered the Oath of Office. Judge Clark's son Thomas held the family bible while his wife Kristen and daughter Katherine assisted with the robing. Honorable Harold K. Brode, Kent County Register of Wills led the Pledge of Allegiance. Governor Jack Markell, State Senator, President Pro Tempore Patricia Blevins, and President of the Delaware Bar Association Yvonne Saville made remarks.

Judge Clark practiced law with Schmittinger & Rodriguez, PA, in Dover for the past eighteen years. During that time, he also served as an attorney for the Delaware State Senate from 1997 to 2002, and as Chief Attorney for the Senate from 2002 through 2012. Additionally, he served as a member of the Smyrna School Board for fifteen years. Judge Clark also served as a Commissioner on Delaware's Public Service Commission from 2005 until his recent appointment as Judge for the Superior Court. He further served as an Editor for the Delaware Law Review for a number of years and for two terms as a Member of Delaware's Preliminary Review Committee for the Board of Professional Responsibility.

Judge Clark is a graduate of Smyrna High School. He then attended the United States Military Academy at West Point. After his commission and completion of this active duty service as an armor officer, he attended and graduated from Widener University School of Law (summa cum laude) in 1996. He served as a Wolcott Law Clerk for the Honorable Maurice Hartnett with the Delaware Supreme Court.
