The Guardian shall **file a status report** with the Register In Chancery **every year** on the anniversary date of the appointment of Guardian (the date of this Order) as required by the Rules of this Court and at any other time the Court shall direct. The status report shall include the current mailing address of both the disabled person and the Guardian, and the current medical statement from the attending physician setting forth the current medical status of the ward and addressing the need for a continued Guardianship.
- 4. In the event of the disabled person's death, the Guardian shall **notify** the Office of Register in Chancery **within ten (10)** days.
- 5. The Guardian is authorized to pay the following costs of these proceedings:

- 6. The Register in Chancery of this Court is appointed agent of the Guardian to accept service of process on behalf of the Guardian as to any claim arising out of the Guardianship if, by reason of the Guardian's absence from this State, he/she cannot be served.
- 7. The Guardian is relieved from filing financial accountings with the Court. If, in the future, the Guardian comes into possession of additional funds or property belonging to the disabled person or the disabled person becomes gainfully employed, the Guardian shall notify the Court and account for such funds or property as the Court may then direct.
