**DELAWARE COURTS TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON SELF-
REPRESENTED LITIGANTS IN CIVIL CASES**

The Delaware Courts will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 6, 2009 at 6 p.m. to take testimony about issues affecting self-represented litigants in civil cases. Civil cases include custody, child support, consumer and/or landlord/tenant cases. The hearing will be held at the DELDOT Building (Farmington-Felton Room) located at 800 Bay Road, Dover, Delaware 19901.

The public hearing is being held by the Delaware Courts: Fairness for All Task Force. The Task Force is particularly interested in learning about any challenges that self-represented civil litigants might face when trying to file papers or represent themselves in a civil case as well as suggestions for addressing those issues. Members of the public will be given up to three (3) minutes each to testify.
