**STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR ELECTED TO
CONFERENCE OF STATE COURT ADMINISTRATORS
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The Honorable Patricia W. Griffin, State Court Administrator in the Delaware Administrative Office of the Courts, was recently elected to serve on the Conference of State Court Administrators Board of Directors for a 3 year term effective immediately. Prior to her appointment as the State Court Administrator by The Honorable Myron T. Steele, Chief Justice of the Delaware Supreme Court, Judge Griffin was the Chief Magistrate for the Delaware Justice of the Peace Court.

The Conference of State Court Administrators, established in 1955, is dedicated to the improvement of state court systems. Its membership consists of the state court administrator or equivalent official in each of the fifty states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, and the Virgin Islands. The mission of the Conference of State Court Administrators is to provide a national forum to assist state court administrators in the development of a more just, effective, and efficient system of justice.
