The Delaware Administrative Office of the Courts is seeking qualified interpreters to assist non-English speaking litigants. In order to become qualified, one must attend a one-day orientation program; successfully pass a written and an oral examination; and be cleared through a criminal history check. Court interpreters are contractual employees and work on an hourly basis. The first step in the accreditation process is to attend the one-day orientation.
