## Dear Counsel:

I write regarding the Proposed Order filed by the Special Master on July 16, 2015, revised on July 21, 2015.

One objection was filed by Smashburger Master LLC. The objection sought to exclude proposed Prokupek Exhibit 8. The debate is whether the document was acquired improperly.

The objection is overruled. I am satisfied that the independent firm(s) should be allowed access. The potential prejudice is minimal, and resolving the
