**Upon Defendant’s “Motion for Amendment of Postconviction Relief,”
or “Motion for Reconsideration,” and
Motion for Appointment of Counsel – *DENIED*.**

1. On April 16, 2013, the court summarily dismissed Defendant’s fourth Motion for Postconviction Relief. The order of dismissal specifically addressed Defendant’s *Martinez v. Ryan* claim.
