RE: 15% INCREASE OF CERTAIN FEES, COSTS, AND FINES AUTHORIZED

BY HOUSE SUBSTITUTE NO. 2 FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 724

House Substitute No. 2 for House Bill No. 724, as amended by House Amendment No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), part of which was the subject of Policy Directive No. 90-125, "authorizes an increase of 15% in the amount of each fee, cost, fine, assessment, penalty or other non-taxed revenue which has not been increased since 1985 and which is imposed by any state agency or state court as identified in Appendix I" of that legislation.

Appendix I contains a long list of items set forth by governmental department for which this Act has authorized increases. While the application of this legislation to the Justice of the Peace Courts may be subject to question, in an abundance of caution I am directing that the Justice of the Peace Courts immediately implement the following increases in fees,

costs and fines for violations of certain statutes discussed . below.

The first specific authorization for a 15% increase in fines which can arguably by said to apply to the Justice of the Peace Courts results from the specific listing of 11 Del. C., \$4207 in Appendix I. Based on this specific listing it would appear that the fines for Title 11 Misdemeanors and Violations which have not been increased since 1985 should now be increased by 15%. However, when the Truth In Sentencing Act took effect on June 30, 1990, it increased the maximum fines for Class A misdemeanors from \$1000 to \$2000, for Class B Misdemeanors from \$500 to \$1000, and for Violations to \$300 for any first offense, \$600 for a second offense and \$1000 for a third offense of the same Violation occurring within 5 years of sentencing for the previous violations. Consequently, since these fines were increased since 1985, they are specifically exempted from any increase authorized by the Act.

The next possibly applicable authorization for an increase in fines is listed under the Department of Public Safety but is designated "Highway Fines . . . Title 21." After extensive research, I have determined that fines for the Title 21 offenses listed on the attached Exhibit A have remained unchanged since 1985 and accordingly should be increased to the amounts represented in Exhibit A. The fines imposed under 21 Del. C. \$4169 for speeding are not affected by this legislation since they were increased on July 9, 1986. However, for your convenience, I have attached Exhibit B which is a revised speeding penalty chart to be copied for use on the bench.

Exhibit B contains the points, fines, revised Victims Compensation Fund assessments, court costs and resulting totals for both first and subsequent speeding offenses listed by the number of miles per hour over the speed limit.

The only remaining item on Appendix I affecting the Justice of the Peace Courts is an authorization for an increase in the fines listed under 19 <u>Del. C.</u>, §3383. In these cases, the new range of fines should read "not less than \$23 nor more than \$230..."

In the area of Court Costs, the only Justice of the Peace Court fees and costs that have not been increased since 1985 are the following:

	Previously	Now
1. For preparation of commitment and detention forms	\$2.00	\$2.30
2. For preparation of bail, judgment and appeal bonds, each bond	\$2.00	\$2.30

Finally, it is important to note that Section 3 of the Act requires that the all fractional dollar amounts resulting from the 15% increase authorized by the Act are to be rounded up to the next multiple of five cents. For example, an 18% VCF assessment of a \$29.00 speeding fine is actually \$5.22. However, because the Act requires this rounding up, the amount of the assessment which must be paid is \$5.25.

(b) Any person who violates any requirement of this chapter, specifically relating to weight of a vehicle or a combination of vehicles, such that said vehicle shall be classified as an "overweight vehicle," shall in addition to whatever other penalties may be allowed by law be punished as follows:

(1) A first offense shall be punishable by a fine for all excess weight up to and including 5,000 pounds in the amount of 2 cents per pound and a fine for all excess weight over 5,000 pounds in the amount of 5 cents per pound or by a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days or both.

(2) Each subsequent offense shall be punishable by a fine for all excess weight up to and including 5,000 pounds in the amount of 5 cents per pound and a fine for all excess weight over 5,000 pounds in the amount of 10 cents per pound or by a term of imprisonment not to exceed 60 days or both.

(c) For purposes of this section a first offense shall be defined as one not previously committed by the person charged within the previous 24 months prior to the date of the offense. A subsequent like offense shall be deemed to have occurred if the person charged has previously been convicted or charged and subsequently convicted of the same offense within the previous 24 months prior to the date of this offense.


