C.* § 4372(e)(1).
2. That copies of this Court’s Order be delivered to the Petitioner or Petitioner’s Attorney, the Delaware Department of Justice, and the State Bureau of Identification, pursuant to 11 *Del. C.* § 4372(e)(1).
3. That the Department of Justice and the courts of the State of Delaware take appropriate steps to see that all records not destroyed pursuant to this Order be handled in such a manner as to ensure that such records not be open to public inspection or disclosure.
4. That it shall not be necessary for the Petitioner to disclose that he or she was arrested, charged or convicted in the above referenced case(s), and the charge or set of charges related to that case(s), for any reason except as provided under 11 *Del. C.* § 4376(a).
