**Closure of Alico Road extended to Nov. 3 at the Leonard L. Williams  
Justice Center in Wilmington**

The closure of Alico Road, at the Leonard L. Williams Justice Center, has been extended until Nov. 3, 2025.

The road, which provides access to the parking garage at the justice center from N. King St., was closed on Aug. 11, 2025 due to ongoing construction at the adjacent Custom House property. Justice center visitors will still be able to access the parking garage from the Walnut St. side entrance to the structure.

Alico Road was originally scheduled to reopen on Sept. 22, 2025, however, changes in the construction schedule require the road to remain closed an additional five weeks, to allow construction crews to store and access construction materials at the site.

Renovation of the Custom House, which was constructed in 1855, began in December 2023 and will expand the historic structure by adding 51,650 square feet to the existing 15,000 square foot building. Once opened, it will house administrative offices for the Delaware Judiciary. Renovation work will also restore the historic second floor courtroom in the building that was the first federal courtroom in the State of Delaware.
