Justice Valihura to serve as opening keynote speaker for 2017 Directors Forum in San Diego.

Delaware Supreme Court Justice Karen Valihura will be the opening keynote speaker at the 12th Annual Directors Forum in San Diego Jan. 22 to Jan. 24, 2017.

Justice Valihura was sworn in as a Justice of the Supreme Court in July 2014 and before joining the bench was a partner at Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP where she focused on corporate litigation including complex commercial and corporate governance issues, federal and state securities matters, as well as mergers and acquisitions and other transactional litigation.

Other keynote speakers at the three-day conference include Stephen Moore, Distinguished Fellow at the Heritage Foundation and Economic Advisor to President-Elect Donald Trump; David L. Sokol, the Chair and CEO of Teton Captiol LLC (formerly with Berkshire Hathaway and MidAmerican Energy Holdings Co.) and Clifton Robbins, the Founder & CEO of Blue Harbour Group L.P.

The Forum, which will be held on the campus of the University of San Diego, "is the premier conference that uniquely brings together investors, management and directors" and gives these leaders with diverse, sometimes opposing, viewpoints the opportunity to engage in candid discussions about the most pressing topics impacting business.
