Matter of Agostini, Del. Supr., 618 A.2d 90 (1992)

Disciplinary Rules: DLRPC 8.4(b), 8.4(c)

Nature of Case:

After an emergency interim suspension was ordered by the Supreme Court following criminal charges against the respondent for felony theft, the Court made further findings as to whether the suspension should continue. The Court found that Disciplinary Counsel had presented sufficient evidence that the respondent had been charged with a serious crime, that a warrant for his arrest had been issued, that he had embezzled and absconded with client funds, and that he had confessed this misconduct to his brother, another member of the Delaware Bar.

Action Taken by the Court:

The Court confirmed and continued the suspension of the respondent until further order of the Court.
