## ORDER

After careful consideration of the appellant's opening brief, the State's motion to affirm, and the Superior Court record, we conclude that the judgment below should be affirmed on the basis of and for the reasons assigned by the Superior Court's order, dated December 31, 2019,¹ adopting the Commissioner's Report and Recommendation, dated December 10, 2019,² and denying the appellant's motion for postconviction relief. We also conclude that the Superior Court did not abuse its

discretion by declining to appoint counsel to assist the appellant, who pleaded guilty, in the postconviction proceedings.<sup>3</sup>
