ORDER

After considering the appellant’s opening brief, the State’s motion to affirm, and the record on appeal, we conclude that the judgment below should be affirmed on the basis of and for the reasons assigned by the Superior Court in its August 20, 2024 order summarily dismissing the appellant’s seventh motion for postconviction relief.¹ We warn the appellant that if he continues to file appeals from untimely and successive motions for postconviction relief, he will be enjoined from filing future appeals without leave of the Court.
