ORDER

On December 3, 2024, the Chief Deputy Clerk sent a notice of brief delinquency to the appellant, Darshon Adkins, because he had not filed an opening brief by the November 27, 2024 deadline set by the Court. On December 17, 2024, the Chief Deputy Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, to Adkins directing him to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for his failure to file an opening brief. Adkins received the notice, as evidenced by the return receipt filed with the Court on December 26, 2024. A timely response to the notice was due on or before January 6, 2025.
