ORDER

On January 8, 2026, the Senior Court Clerk sent a letter directing the appellant to pay the Family Court filing fee on or before January 22, 2026, or this Court would issue a notice to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. On January 23, 2026, the Chief Deputy Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, directing the appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for the appellant's failure to pay the Family Court filing fee. Postal records reflect that the appellant received the notice to show cause on February 10, 2026. The appellant having failed to respond to the notice to show cause within the required ten-day period, dismissal of this appeal is deemed to be unopposed.
