ORDER

The Court issued a briefing schedule in this appeal on January 28, 2026; the appellant's opening brief was due February 27. The appellant did not file an opening brief. On March 5, the Chief Deputy Clerk sent a brief delinquency notice to the appellant. The appellant did not respond to the letter and did not file an opening brief. On March 13, the Chief Deputy Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, directing the appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed because the appellant had not filed an opening brief and appendix. The postal service left notice of attempted delivery on March 16. On March 31, the Chief Deputy Clerk reissued the notice to show cause by both certified and first-class mail. The appellant having failed to respond to the notice to show cause within the required ten-day period or to file the opening brief, dismissal of this action is deemed unopposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, under Supreme Court Rules 3(b)(2) and 29(b), that the appeal is DISMISSED.
