**DESIGNATION OF SUPERIOR COURT CIVIL CASES
FOR ELECTRONIC FILING PURSUANT TO
SUPERIOR COURT CIVIL RULE 79.1**

This 29th day of November, 2007:

As the first state court in the nation to implement electronic filing in 1991, the Superior Court has direct experience with eFiling through LexisNexis File & Serve with the speed, efficiency, storage savings and cost savings that electronic filing provides the Court, counsel and litigants. Eventually the system will apply to all civil filings in the Superior Court. This Directive is made to expand the use of eFiling to all Civil Complaints including Mechanic's Liens and Mortgages.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS DIRECTED as follows:

**DESIGNATION OF COMPLAINTS, MECHANIC'S LIENS AND
MORTGAGE CASES FOR EFILING PURSUANT TO SUPERIOR
COURT CIVIL RULE 79.1**

1. Effective January 1, 2008, all new Civil Complaints, Mechanic's Liens, and Mortgage cases filed with the Prothonotary in any county

whether subject to Alternative Dispute Resolution (“ADR”) or not shall be filed and/or served electronically using the LexisNexis File & Serve eFiling system.

2. It is noted that this designation does not include Civil Appeals, Involuntary Commitments, or Civil Miscellaneous proceedings.
