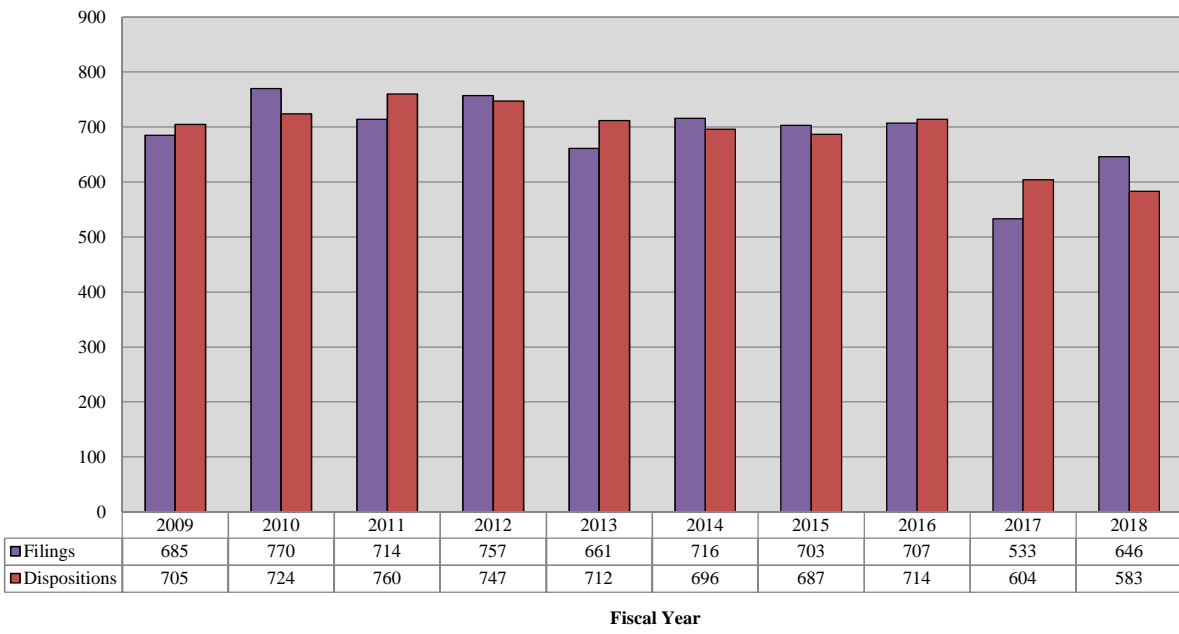

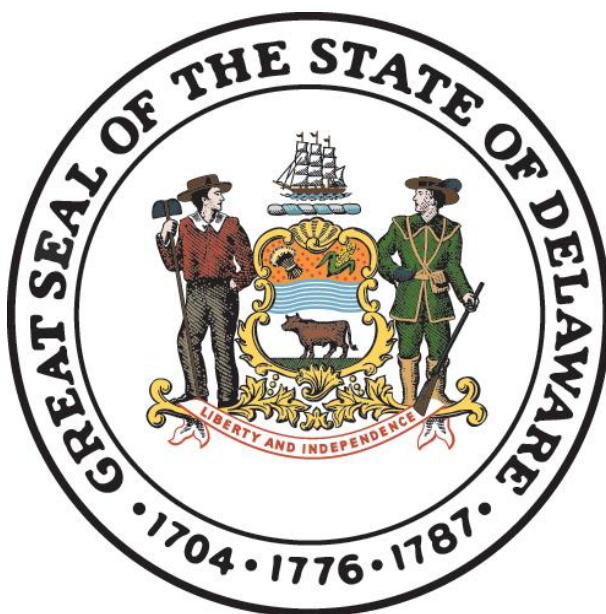

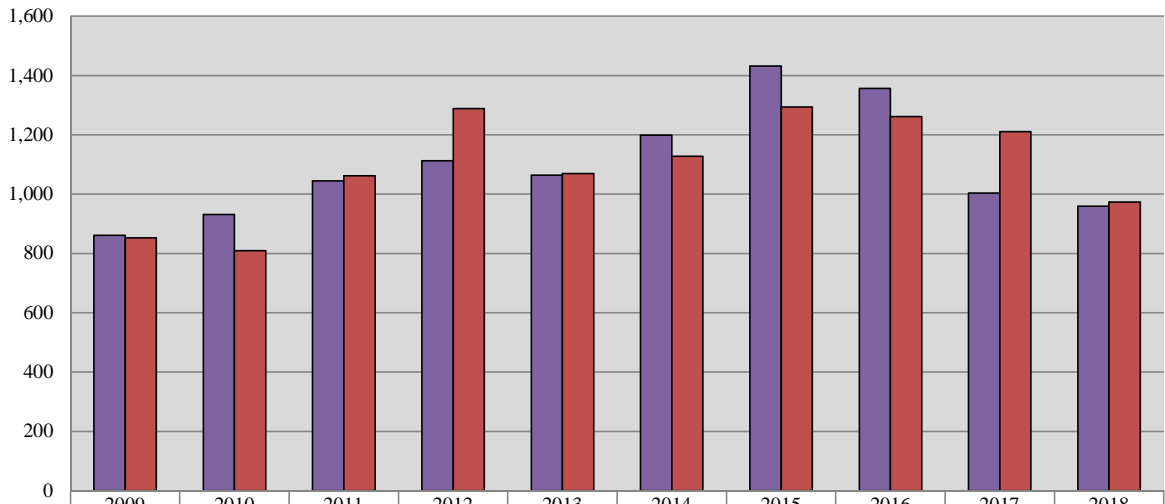

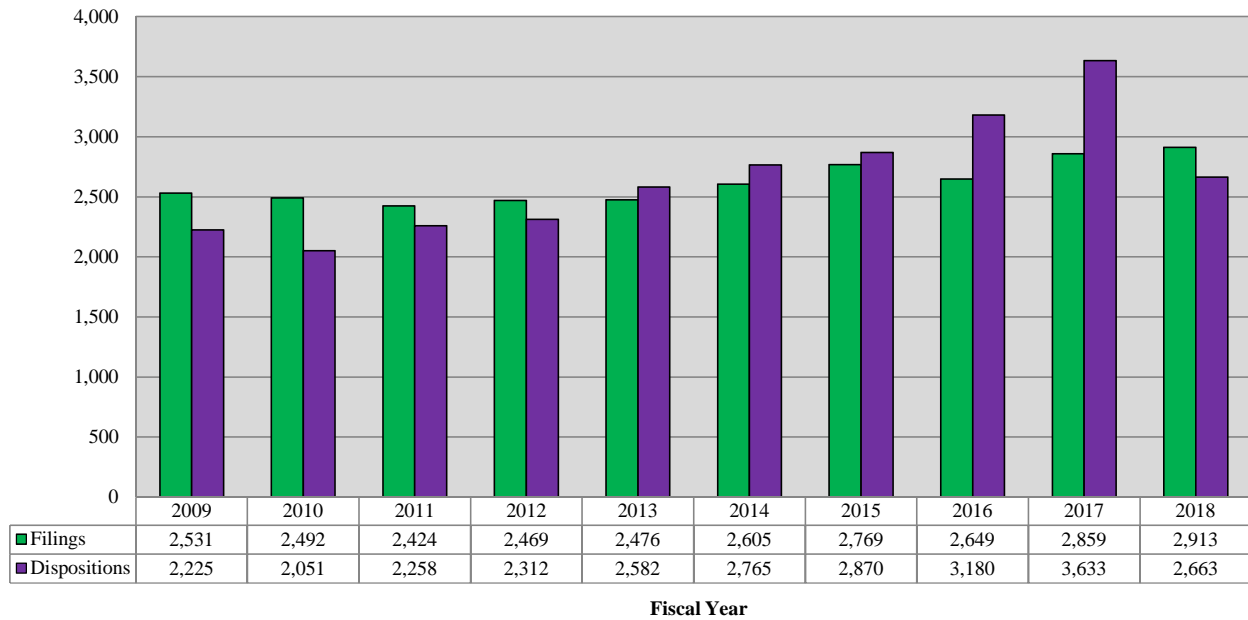

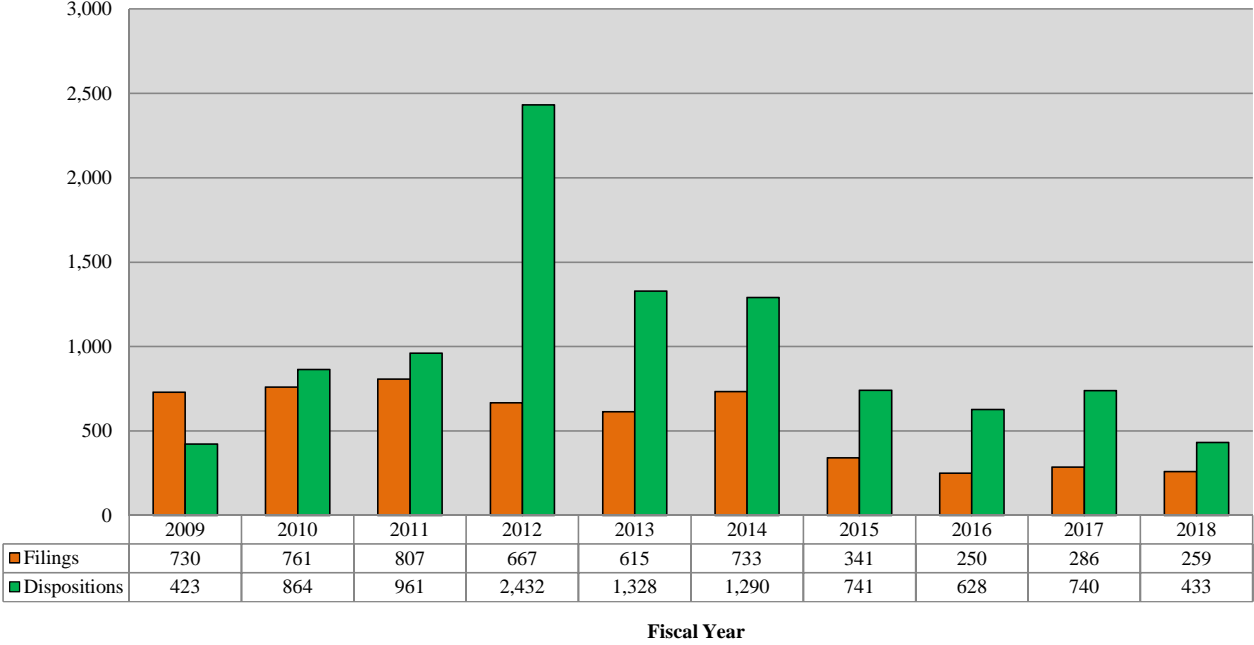

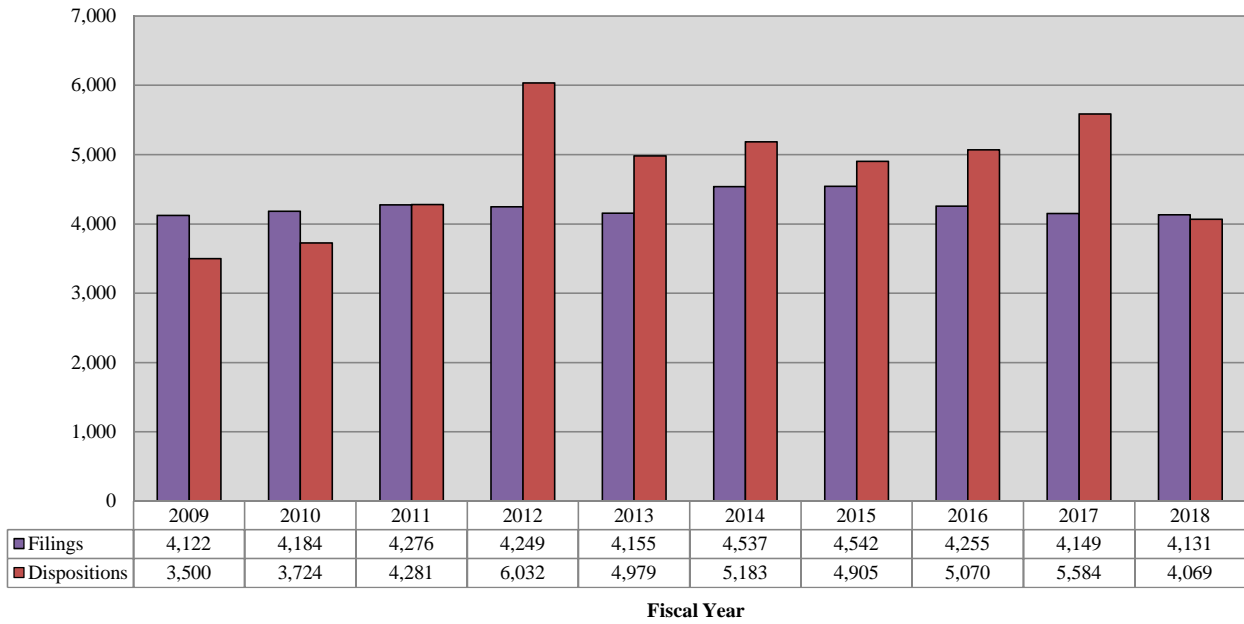

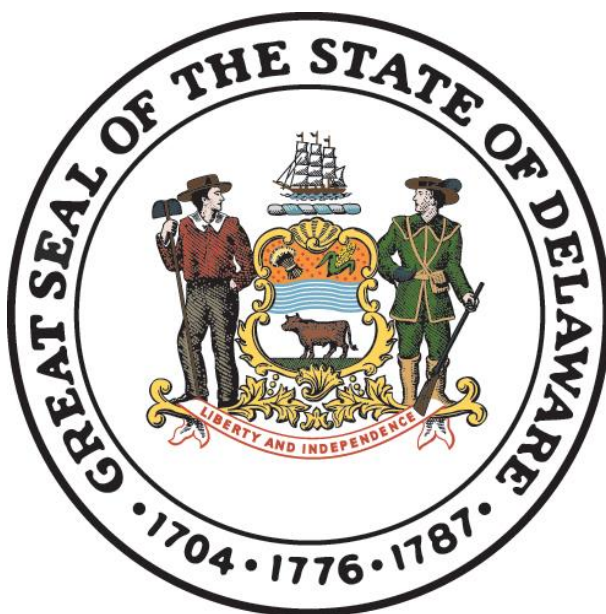

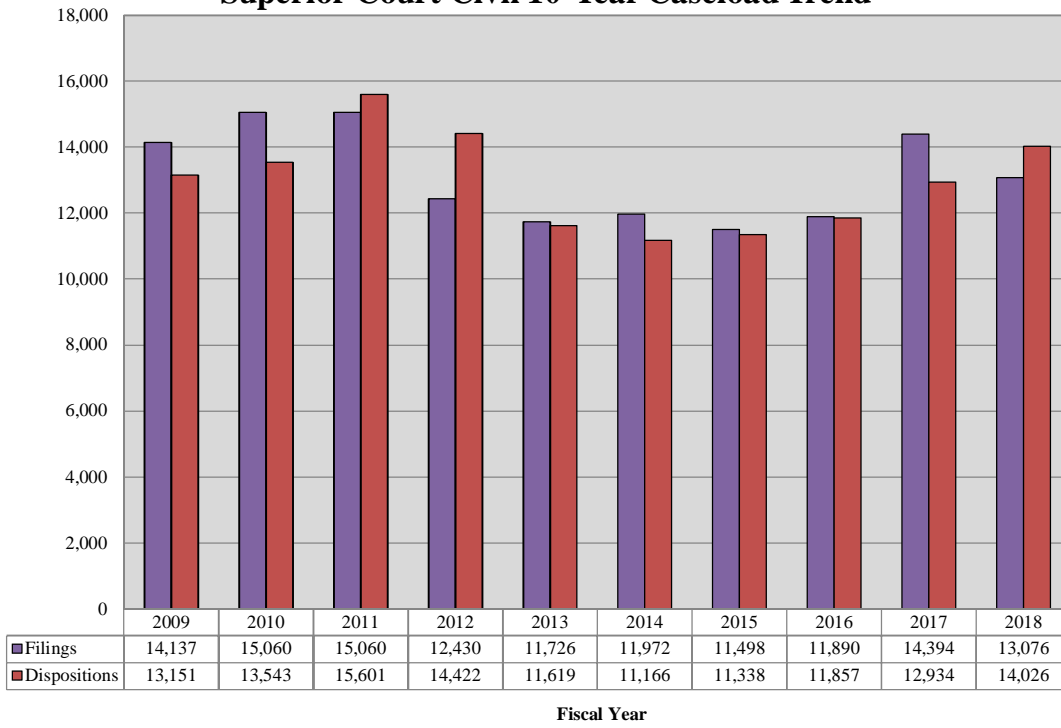

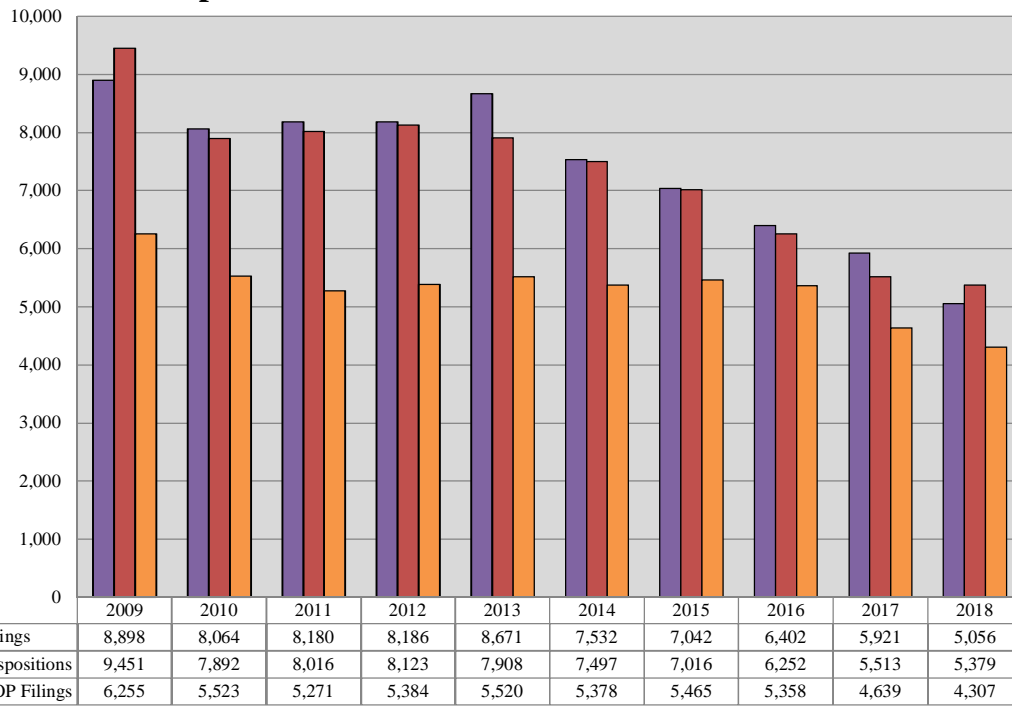

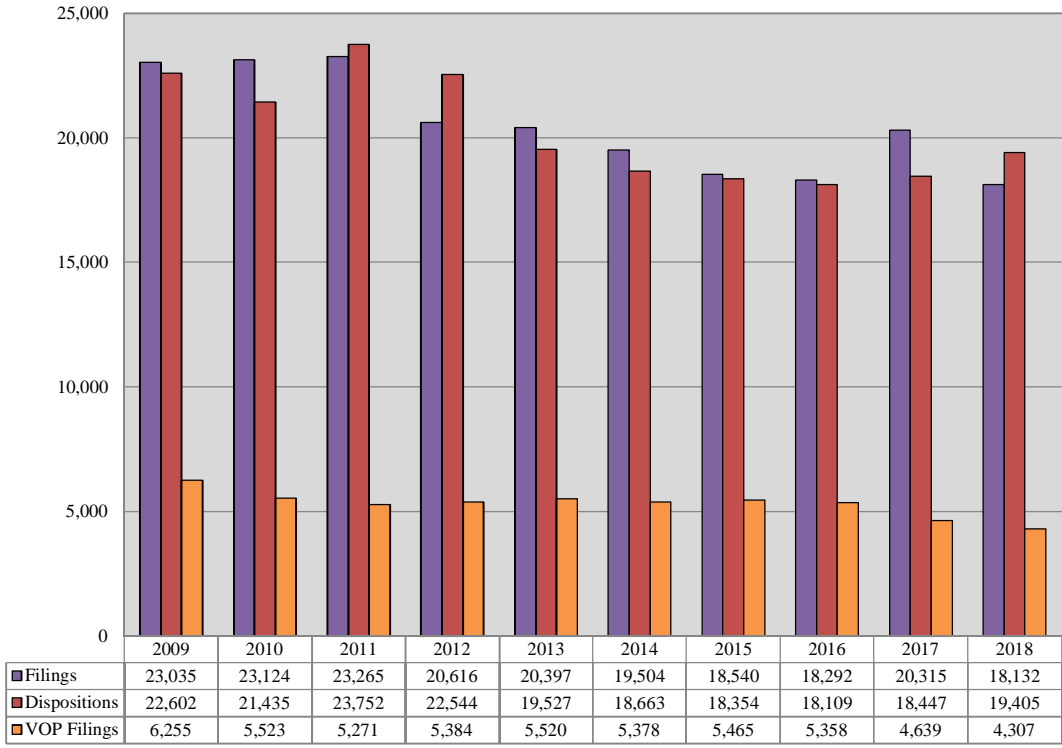

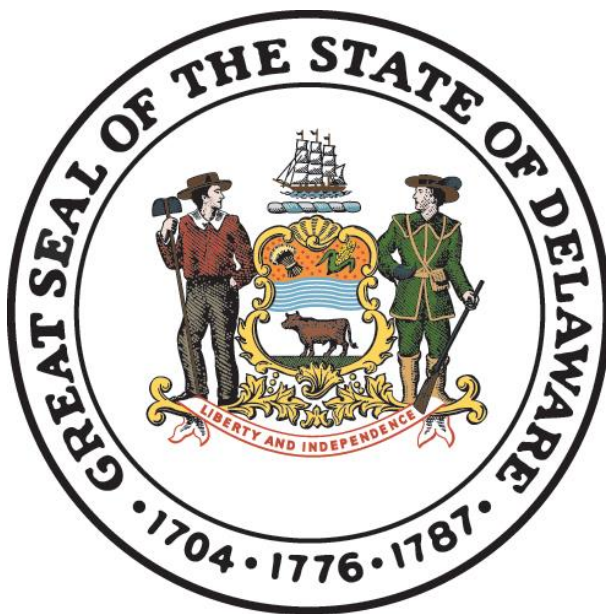

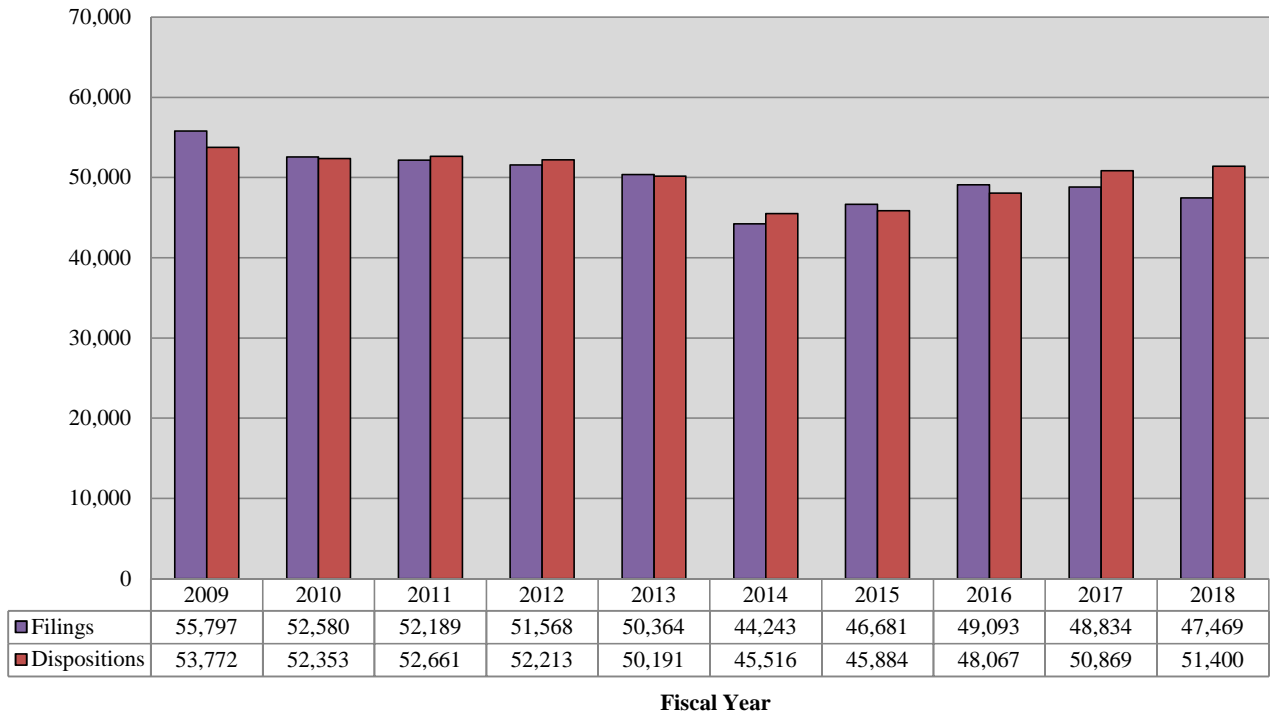

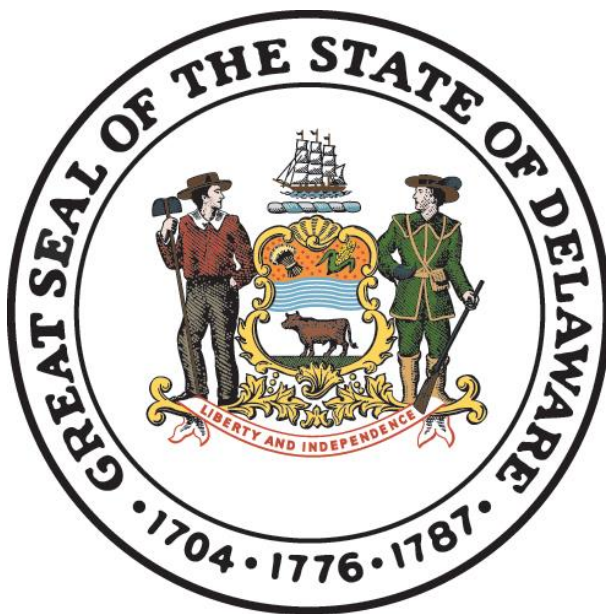

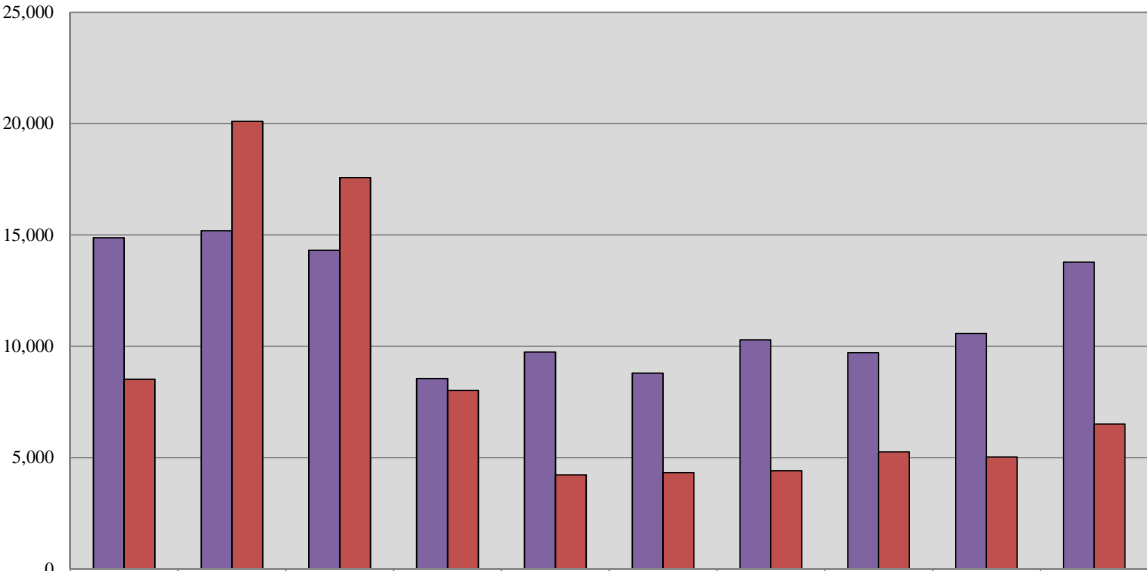

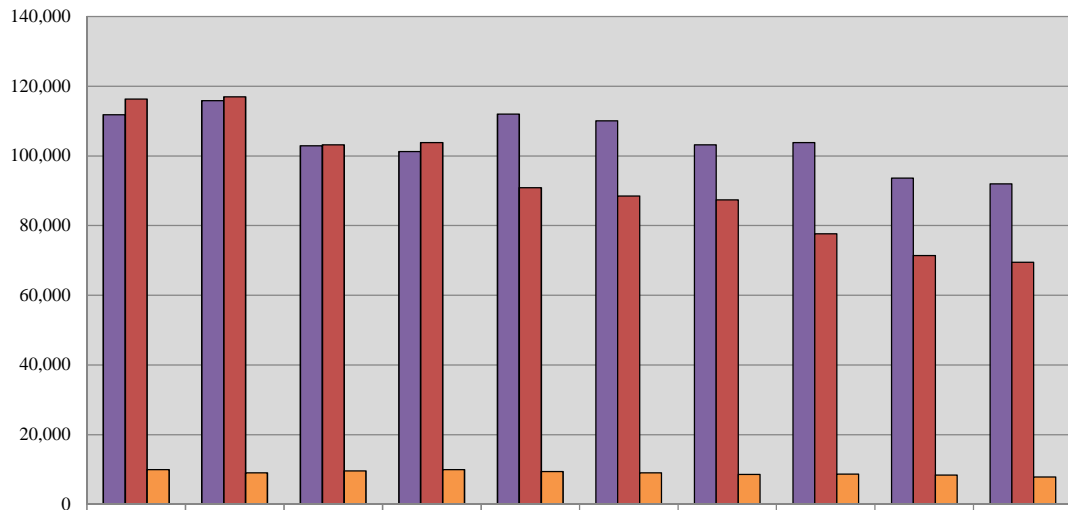

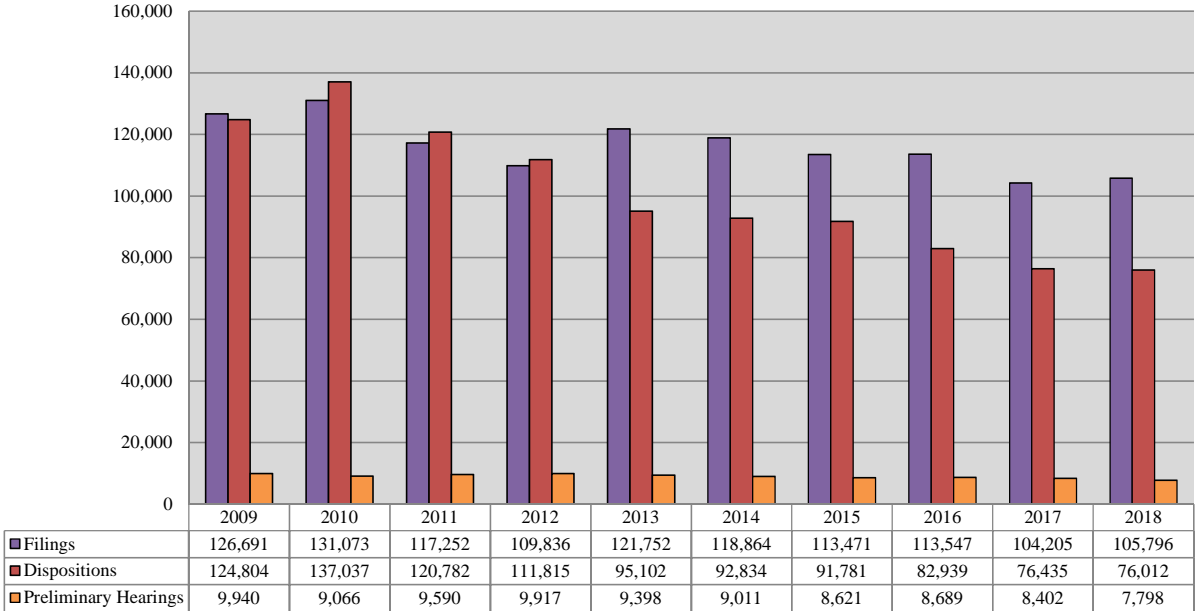

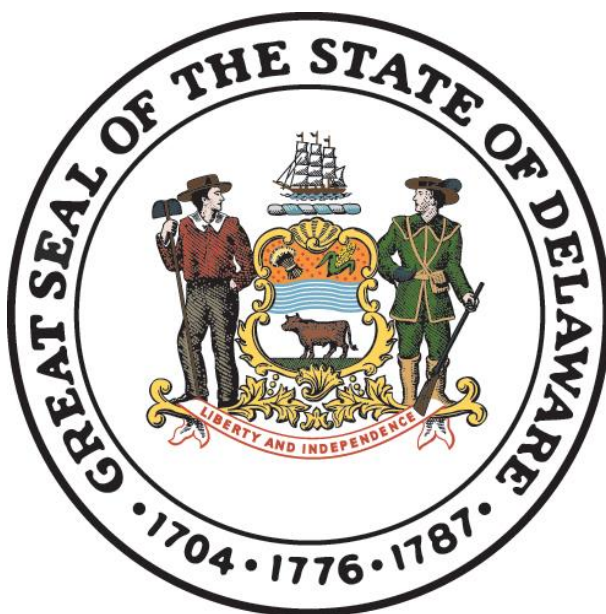

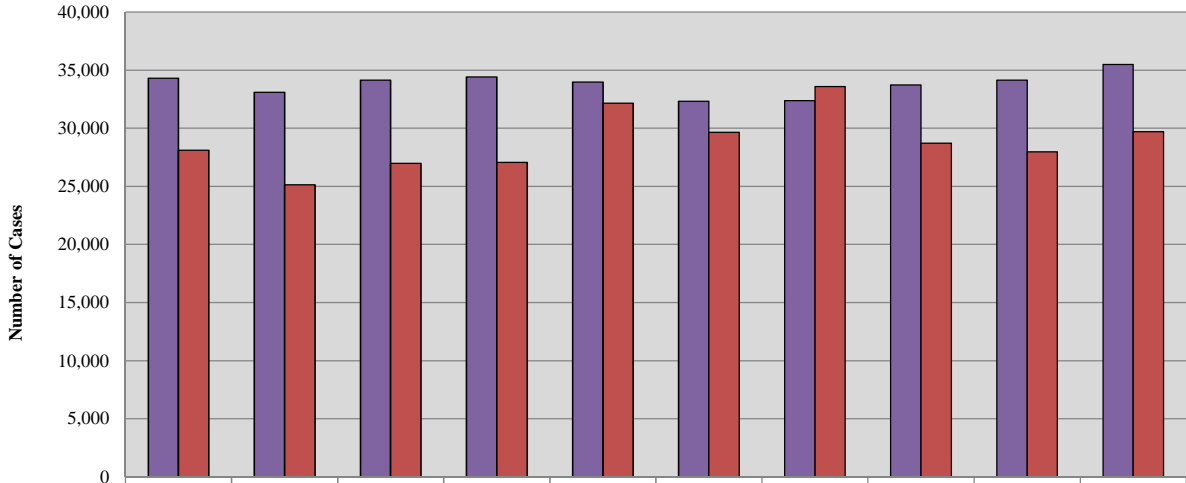

JP Court 10-Year Civil Caseload Trend



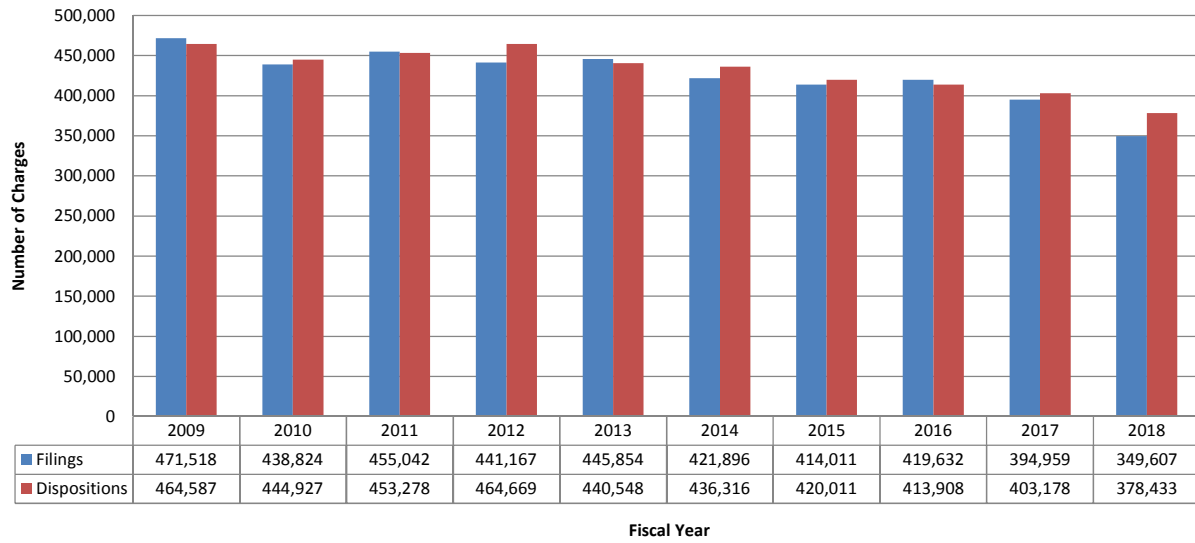

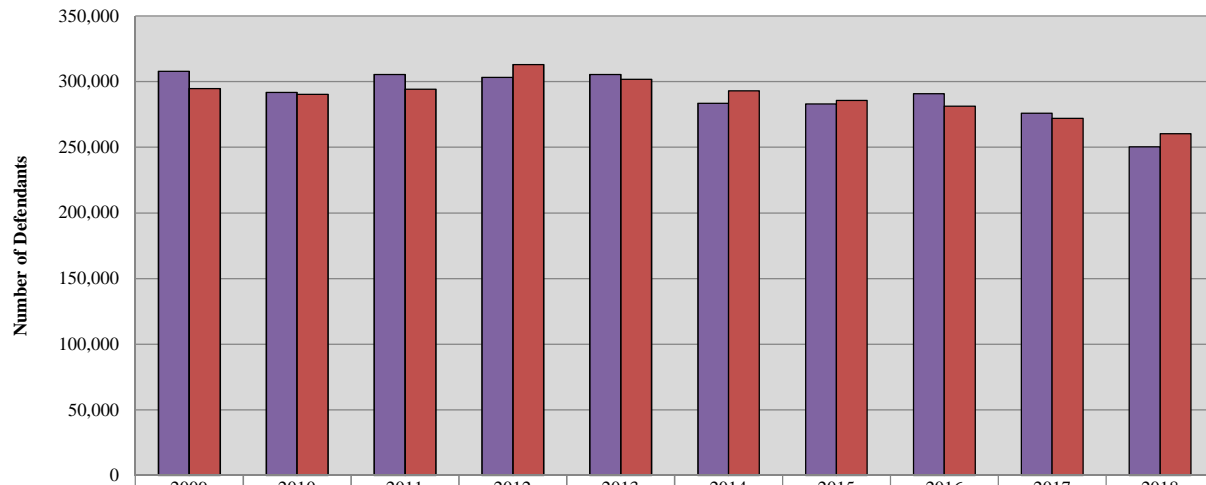

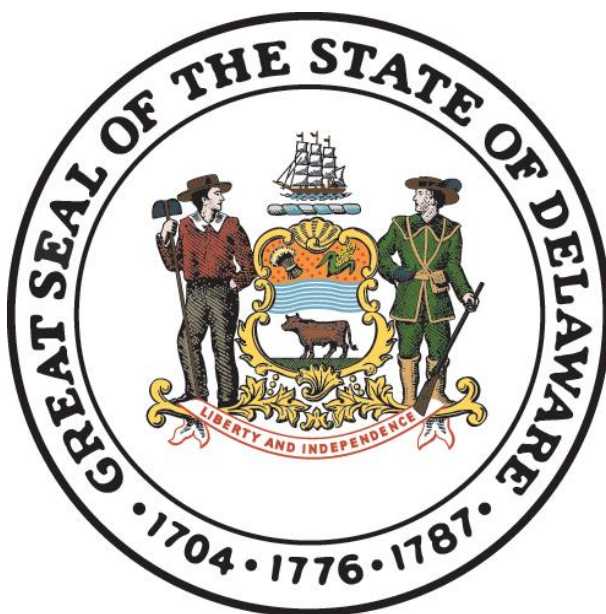
**JP Court 10-Year Total Caseload Trend*
