NOTICE OF VACANCY

The Judicial Nominating Commission gives public notice that it is **extending the submission period** for the following office, which may be filled by the appointment of the Governor with the concurrence of the Senate:

Commissioner of the Court of Common Pleas, Kent County
(Due to the creation of a new position)

The appointee must be a resident of this State and duly admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware. The position provides a current annual salary of \$116,646.

Persons who meet the legal qualifications of the office described above are invited to file with the Commission a completed copy of the “Questionnaire for Nominees for Judicial Office.” The Questionnaire is available online at <http://courts.delaware.gov/career/> under the heading “Judicial Officer Postings.” Any person who wishes to suggest candidates may write to the Commission.

Completed Questionnaires and supporting application materials must be completed in accordance with the Instructions on page 1 of the Questionnaire and must be received no later than **12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, February 4, 2022** at the address listed below. Candidates must also email a copy of the completed Questionnaire and supporting materials no later than **12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, February 4, 2022** to JNC@delaware.gov. **Submissions that do not satisfy both requirements will not be accepted.** The Commission will schedule interviews of candidates thereafter.

Candidates should arrange for a background check with the State Bureau of Identification as promptly as possible to ensure timely submission. Additional information is contained in the Instructions section of the Questionnaire.
