The Judicial Nominating Commission gives public notice that it has received notification from the Governor that the following office may be filled by the appointment of the Governor with the concurrence of the Senate:

Judge of the Superior Court of the State of Delaware, New Castle County

(Due to the retirement of the Honorable Diane Clarke Streett)

The appointee shall be a citizen of the State and learned in the law.

In accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the Delaware Constitution, the Governor must appoint a Democrat. The position of Judge provides a current annual salary of \$185,444.00.

Persons who meet the legal qualifications of the office described above are invited to file with the Commission a completed copy of the "Questionnaire for Nominees for Judicial Office." The Questionnaire is available online at <http://courts.delaware.gov/career/> under the heading "Judicial Officer Postings." Any person who wishes to suggest candidates may write to the Commission.

Questionnaires and supporting application materials must be completed in accordance with the Instructions on page 1 of the Questionnaire and must be received no later than **12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, February 4, 2022** at the address listed below. Candidates must also email a copy of the completed Questionnaire and supporting application materials no later than **12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, February 4, 2022** to JNC@delaware.gov. **Submissions that do not satisfy both requirements will not be accepted.** The Commission will schedule interviews of candidates promptly thereafter.

Candidates should arrange for a background check with the State Bureau of Identification as promptly as possible to ensure timely submission. Additional information is contained in the Instructions section of the Questionnaire.
