Judge of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Sussex County

who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware and shall have been a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment per 10 Del. C. §906(e). The position provides a current annual salary of \$199,612.

Commissioner of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Kent County

(Due to the expiration of the term of the Honorable Emily Farley,
who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware and shall have been a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment per 10 Del. C. §915(a). The position provides a current annual salary of \$127,043.

An emailed copy of the application materials must also be received **no later than 12:00 pm (noon) on October 7, 2022**, at JNC@delaware.gov. **Submissions that do not satisfy both requirements will not be accepted.** The Commission will schedule interviews of candidates promptly thereafter.

Please arrange for a background check with the State Bureau of Identification as promptly as possible to ensure timely submission. Additional information regarding the background check process is contained in the Instructions section of the Questionnaire.
