The Judicial Nominating Commission gives public notice that it has received notification from the Governor that the following offices may be filled by the appointment of the Governor with the concurrence of the Senate:

### **Judge of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Kent County**

(Due to the expiration of the term of the Honorable Mardi Pyott,  
who will be seeking reappointment)

Pursuant to 10 Del. C. § 906, the appointee shall be duly admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of this State for a period not less than 5 years prior to appointment, and shall have been a resident of the State for a period of 5 years immediately prior to appointment. The position provides a current annual salary of \$205,600.

### **Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of the State of Delaware, Sussex County**

(Due to the retirement of the Honorable Kenneth Clark, Jr.)

Pursuant to 10 Del. C. § 1302 the appointee must be a citizen of the State of Delaware and learned in the law. In addition, the appointee must have been actively engaged in the general practice of law in the State for at least five years. The position provides a current annual salary of \$194,720.

### **Commissioner of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, New Castle County**

who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of this State and be a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment per 10 Del. C. § 915(a). The position provides a current annual salary of \$133,141.

### **Commissioner of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Kent County**

(Due to the retirement of the Honorable David Jones)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of this State and be a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment per 10 Del. C. § 915(a). The position provides a current annual salary of \$133,141.
