The Judicial Nominating Commission gives public notice that it has received notification from the Governor that the following offices may be filled by the appointment of the Governor with the concurrence of the Senate:

### **Vice Chancellor of the Court of Chancery**

(Due to the retirement of the Honorable Sam Glasscock, III)

The appointee must be a citizen of the State and learned in the law. In accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the Delaware Constitution, the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Democratic party. The position provides a current, annual salary of \$211,358.

### **Judge of the Superior Court of the State of Delaware, New Castle County**

(Due to the expiration of term of the Honorable Eric M. Davis,  
who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be a citizen of the State and learned in the law. In accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the Delaware Constitution, the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Republican party. The position provides a current annual salary of \$211,358.

### **Judge of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Sussex County**

(Due to the expiration of term of the Honorable Paula Ryan,  
who will be seeking reappointment)

Pursuant to 10 Del. C. section 906, the appointee shall be duly admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of this State for a period not less than 5 years prior to appointment, and shall have been a resident of the State for a period of 5 years immediately prior to appointment. Pursuant to 10 Del. C. section 906(a), the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Democratic party. The position provides a current annual salary of \$211,358.

### **Commissioner of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, New Castle County**

(Due to the expiration of term of the Honorable Paraskevi Wolcott,  
who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be duly admitted to practice law before the Supreme Court of this State and shall be a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment, per 10 Del. C. section 915(a). The position provides a current annual salary of \$139,532.

**Commissioner of the Family Court of the State of Delaware, Sussex County**

(Due to the expiration of term of the Honorable Sonja Truitt Wilson,  
who will be seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be duly admitted to practice law before the Supreme Court of this State and shall be a resident of the State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment, per 10 Del. C. section 915(a). The position provides a current annual salary of \$139,532.
