The Judicial Nominating Commission gives public notice that it has received notification from the Governor that the following offices may be filled by the appointment of the Governor with the concurrence of the Senate:

Vice Chancellor of the Court of Chancery

(Due to the expiration of term of the Honorable J. Travis Laster, who is seeking reappointment)

The appointee shall be a citizen of the State and learned in the law. In accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the Delaware Constitution, the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Democratic party. The position of Vice Chancellor provides a current annual salary of \$185,444.00.

Judge of the Family Court, Sussex County

(Due to the retirement of the Honorable Kenneth M. Millman)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware and be a resident of Sussex County. In accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the Delaware Constitution, the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Democratic party. The position provides a current annual salary of \$185,444.00.

Commissioner of the Superior Court, New Castle County

(Due to the elevation to the Court of Common Pleas of the Honorable Katharine L. Mayer)

The appointee shall be admitted to the practice of law before the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware and be a resident of New Castle County. There is also a requirement of political balance under 10 Del. C. §511(a); the Governor may not nominate a candidate from the Democratic party. The position provides a current annual salary of \$115,452.00.

Persons who meet the legal qualifications of the office described above are invited to file with the Commission a completed copy of the "Questionnaire for Nominees for Judicial Office." The Questionnaire is available online at <http://courts.delaware.gov/career/> under the heading "Judicial Officer Postings." Any person who wishes to suggest candidates may write to the Commission.

Completed Questionnaires and supporting application materials must be completed in accordance with the Instructions on page 1 of the Questionnaire and must be received no later than 12:00 pm (noon) on Monday, June 28, 2021 at the address listed below. Applicants must also email a copy of the completed Questionnaire and supporting application materials no later than 12:00 pm (noon) on Monday, June 28, 2021 to JNC@delaware.gov. **Submissions that do not satisfy both requirements will not be accepted.** The Commission will schedule interviews of

candidates thereafter.

Please arrange background checks with the State Bureau of Identification as promptly as possible to ensure timely submission. Additional information is contained in the Instructions section of the Questionnaire.
