

**MILITARY SPOUSE SUPERVISING ATTORNEY’S CERTIFICATE**

  - (c) Supreme Court Rule 55.4 and all other rules and regulations applicable to individuals receiving a Certificate of Limited Practice as a Military Spouse in Delaware.
- (6) I will assist and promote Applicant’s compliance with the Delaware Lawyers’ Rules of Professional Conduct, the Delaware Lawyers’ Rules of Disciplinary Procedure, the Principles of Professionalism for Delaware Lawyers, this Rule, and all other rules and regulations applicable to individuals receiving a Certificate of Limited Practice as a Military Spouse in Delaware.
