Delaware's home visiting programs work to support families through pregnancy and early childhood

FIMR findings in 2020



44%

of mothers may have been eligible for home visiting services



14%

of mothers were appropriately referred for home visiting



44%

of women experienced multiple stressors during pregnancy

However no FIMR mothers were enrolled in home visiting programs



The **CDRC Home Visiting Committee** is working to overcome barriers and improve the home visiting service system for at-risk families.

The committee began its work in 2019 and launched the following workgroups: health, reimbursement, sustainability, managed care organizations and Medicaid, and innovative universal models.

A final report is expected to be released in 2022.
