

Delaware Supreme Court Approves Amendments To Board of Bar Examiners Rules 5, 15, and 51(f)

By order dated January 19, 2017 and effective January 19, 2017, the Supreme Court has approved amendments to Board of Bar Examiners Rules 5, 15, and 51(f). The amendments to Rules 5 and 15 change the time frames for the submission and consideration of ADA requests for accommodations and the final application deadline. The amendment to Rule 51(f) exempts non-Delaware attorneys who are admitted under Supreme Court Rule 55, and who provide services to an approved organization without compensation, from sitting for the Delaware Bar Examination.
