- Completed Foreign Legal Consultant Application
- NCBE Acknowledgment of Complete Application
- Completed NCBE Character and Fitness Application
- One recent photograph (same size used for passport - do not upload copy of your passport)
- Executed Authorization and Release Form.
- Copy of each passport
- Certificates of good standing in all jurisdictions admitted and duly authenticated English translation if not in English
- Complete and current credit report dated within 60 days of application
- Letter of recommendation signed by and with the official seal, if any, of one of the members of the executive body of such authority listed in your answer to 10(A) in application
- Detailed summary of the nature and extent of your practice of law in foreign nation(s) for which you seek certification
- Letter of recommendation from at least two (2) attorneys, counselors at law, or the equivalent admitted in and practicing in each foreign nation where the applicant is admitted
- Check in the amount of \$1,825 made payable to the "Board of Bar Examiners"

IF APPLICABLE

- Copy of driver's license or other form of identification card issued by any state within the United States
- Proof of your citizenship status or INS status
- Question 31 Authorization and release – if you Answered yes to NCBE Question 31
- Question 37 Authorization and release – if you Answered yes to NCBE Question 37
