- Official Law School Transcript conferring degree of Juris Doctor
- Official undergraduate and post graduate transcript(s) including any study abroad
- Complete and current credit report from one of the following– Experian, Transunion or Equifax – dated within 60 days of your Rule 55 application submission
- Federal criminal history report dated within 150 days of the application date
- State of Delaware criminal history report dated within 150 days of the application date
- Applications for all law schools attended
- Application(s) for admission to other jurisdictions whether admitted or not
- Certificate(s) of Good Standing in jurisdiction(s) admitted dated within the past 60 days of application
- Third Affidavit of Completeness

- Copy of prior Rule 55 Limited Permission to Practice Application
