## Closure of Alico Road extended at the Leonard L. Williams Justice Center in Wilmington

The closure of Alico Road, at the Leonard L. Williams Justice Center, has been extended beyond Nov. 3, 2025 to accommodate ongoing construction at the adjacent Custom House property.

Because the demands of the construction and renovation at the Custom House are evolving – and crews are working to make sure the effort moves efficiently – no immediate date to reopen Alico Road has been set at this time. The road is expected to re-open before or at the completion of construction work at the Custom House in 2026.

The road, which provides access to the parking garage at the Justice Center from N. King St., was closed on Aug. 11, 2025. Since that time, Justice Center visitors have been able to access the parking garage from the Walnut St. side entrance and will continue to do so.

Renovation of the Custom House, which was constructed in 1855, began in December 2023 and will expand the historic structure by adding 51,650 square feet to the existing 15,000 square foot building. Once opened, it will house administrative offices for the Delaware Judiciary. Renovation work will also restore the historic second floor courtroom in the building that was the first federal courtroom in the State of Delaware.
