Delaware Supreme Court Amends Rules Relating to the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection, Abandoned or Unclaimed Trust Funds, and Attorney Books and Records.

By an order dated November 18, 2025 the Delaware Supreme Court has adopted amendments to various rules relating to the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection, abandoned or unclaimed trust funds, and attorney and law firm books and records. The amendments affect Supreme Court Rule 66, 69, and 73; the Rules of the Trustees of the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection; and Rule 1.15 of the Delaware Lawyers' Rules of Professional Conduct. The amendments are effective November 20, 2025, and are available on the Court's website.
