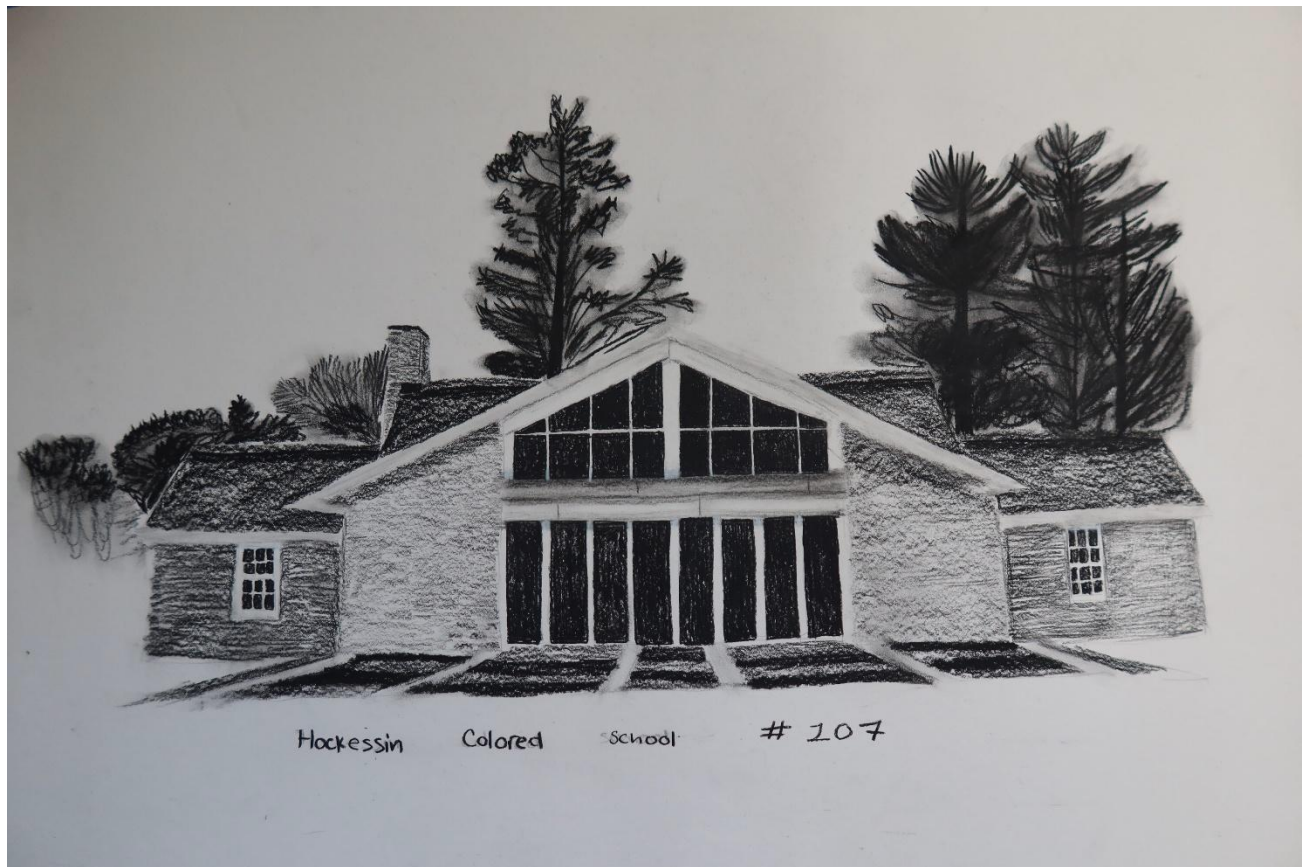




*Hockessin Colored School No. 107*

Board of Education* that ruled that racial segregation in schools was inherently unequal and therefore unconstitutional. Now, the school is renamed the Center for Diversity, Inclusion & Social Equity and serves the community as a space to promote equity and equality.
