SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT OF RETRIALS

This day of October 1994, IT IS DIRECTED:

- (1) If a criminal or civil case must be retried because of a mistrial having been declared or because of a ruling by the Supreme Court, the original trial judge is assigned to the case for all purposes until final disposition.
- (2) An exception for "good cause" shall exist when there is a basis for recusal of the trial judge or where the judge's other trial commitments would prevent the prompt retrial of the case.
