

Delaware Supreme Court Amends Delaware Supreme Court Rule 10.2

As contemplated by the Court's July 18, 2018 Order adopting recommendations to improve work life balance, the Supreme Court has amended Supreme Court Rule 10.2 to establish a 5:00 p.m. filing deadline in non-expedited cases. This rule amendment is effective on September 14, 2018. The rule amendment is available on the [Court's website](#).

Rule 10.2(6)(a) was amended to provide that all electronic filings, except for notices of appeal, in non-expedited cases must be completed by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time in order to be considered timely filed that day. All notices of appeal and electronic filings in expedited cases must be completed before midnight Eastern Time in order to be considered timely filed that day.
