

Delaware Supreme Court Amends Delaware Supreme Court Rules 62, 64, and 86, Rules 1 and 2 of the Delaware Lawyers' Rules of Professional Conduct and the Rules of the Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law

By an order dated September 12, 2017 and effective September 12, 2017, the Delaware Supreme Court has amended Supreme Court Rules 62, 64, and 86, Rules 1 and 2 of the Delaware Lawyers' Rules of Professional Conduct, and the Rules of the Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law to restructure the Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law and to organize it as a subcommittee of the Board on Professional Responsibility.
